With regards to the "Contract Management System", what is the level of monitoring required and would you like the ability to bill as well?

- General Contract Management;
- Load contract values;
- Have contract linked to finance e.g. Payments against the contracted amounts and prohibit payments above approved contract amounts;
- Alert SCM & Finance when contract is nearing expiry date;
- Version control on the Addendums;
- Restrictions on amendments to specific functions
- Vendor management against the contract

I refer to Section 3.3 in the Terms of Reference in which it suggests that the proposed solution MUST be web based. Our proposed solution provides for a combination of web based front end and a thick desktop client, please can you confirm if this technology will be acceptable.
